## ASHOVER PARISH COUNCIL - TABLE OF CEMETERY CHARGES

Fixed and settled under Statutory Instrument 204/1977 Section 15 by the Parish Council for Ashover acting as the Burial Authority for the Parish of Ashover. A summary of the relevant Burial Authority Regulations can be obtained from the Burial Clerk for the Parish of Ashover

The fees below only apply to interments between the hours of 10.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday unless a coroner or registered medical practitioner issues a certificate for an immediate interment. In all other cases a 50% increase in fees is payable.

The fees do not include the digging of the grave, erection of gravestones, fixing of plaques or laying of cremation slabs unless otherwise stated on the grave deeds.

Only contractors approved by the Burial Board and instructed by the appointed Undertaker will be allowed to carry out this work. Transferring of Grave Rights – Refer to Information Leaflet available at <a href="https://www.ashover-pc.gov.uk">www.ashover-pc.gov.uk</a>.

NB: No kerbstone sets or fencing of any type around the perimeter of the grave space is permitted.

## 5 Part 5 - Search Fees

For each and every request for a search to be made of the Burial Registers (other than by an appointed Funeral Director or Monumental Stonemason) a fee of £20.00 is payable in advance. (Section 8 of the Burial Act 1853 applies)

## 6 Part 6 - Removal and Replacement of Headstones

Any headstones which is removed to allow for subsequent interments, additional inscriptions or replacement of the memorial must be replaced within six months from the date of removal. Failure to do so will result in fresh approval being required and further fees being payable.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that Grave Rights are authorised. Please ensure that the Privacy Notice has been read and Consent Form signed by the applicant and next of kin.
