### 146/23 Parish Maintenance

## 147/23 Health & Safety

A request had been received for a defibrillator to be sited at Stonedge. It had been established that a defibrillator, available to the public, was sited at The Red Lion, Stonedge. **Resolution:** 

- (i) That confirmation is sought that the defibrillator at The Red Lion, Stonedge is registered with 'The Circuit'.
- (ii) That owners of defibrillators are encouraged to register with 'The Circuit' via newsletters and the website, in order to identify the location to the East Midlands Ambulance Service.

# 148/23 Speed Indicator Devices (SIDs)

The installation of a second post at Kelstedge by Derbyshire County Council was awaited. The SIDs had been manufactured and would be installed once both posts were in place. The invoice from Coeval had been received.

### Resolution:

- (i) That Derbyshire County Council is requested to install the second post at Kelstedge as a matter of urgency.
- (ii) That the invoice from Coeval for 2no. SIDs in the sum of £5,632.00 plus VAT is authorised for payment. It was noted that a grant of £3,000.00 towards this cost had been obtained from the Police & Crime Commissioner.

### 149/23 River Amber

Further correspondence had been received from Lee Rowley MP informing of visits to agricultural premises in the parish by the Environment Agency. **Noted.** 

#### 150/23 Parish Events

The Christmas Lights Switch-on would take place on Sunday 03/12/2023 and a road closure application for Church Street had been approved. Ashover Community Medical Centre Ltd. Trustees had granted £400.00 towards the event for the purchase of the Christmas Tree. **Noted.** 

#### **151/23 News Items**

The recent Autumn Newsletter had been received well and future news would include updates on Parish Council projects, 'Jim's' field at Alton, Climate Change Working Group initiatives and updates on the River Amber pollution.

There were no updates on the provision of a chess table under a Government initiative. The anti-litter poster campaign had been progressed with the Primary School. Ideas had been invited from the Primary School for use of land formerly used as an allotment.

# 154/23 Tree Surveys

Surveys had been undertaken on the playing field, car park and allotments. A quotation had been sought from Trueman Specialist Tree Surveys for the recommended work in the sum of £750.00 plus VAT. The contractor had previously undertaken work in the cemetery to a high and safe standard; this was considered essential as some of the work specified was adjacent a right of way.

Resolution: That the quotation from Trueman Specialist Tree Surveys in the sum of £750.00 plus VAT is accepted. The contract would include work identified under the Tree Survey recently undertaken on the playing field, car park and allotments.

# 155/23 Clerk's Report
